

**FACTS** **WHAT DOES CLACKAMAS FEDERAL CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?**

<b>Why?</b>	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
<b>What?</b>	The type of personal information we collect and share depends on the product and service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Social Security Number/Employer/Income</li> <li>• Account balances</li> <li>• Credit history and credit score</li> </ul>
<b>How?</b>	All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons Clackamas Federal Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

<b>Who is providing this notice?</b>	Clackamas Federal Credit Union
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**What we do**

<b>How does Clackamas Federal Credit Union protect my personal information?</b>	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
<b>How does Clackamas Federal Credit Union collect my personal information?</b>	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Open an account</li> <li>• Apply for a loan</li> <li>• Use your credit or debit card</li> </ul> <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus.</p>
<b>Why can't I limit all sharing?</b>	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>• Affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>• Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li> </ul> <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
<b>What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?</b>	A request to limit sharing from one joint owner will limit sharing of all account information and information of other owners of the account.

**Definitions**

<b>Affiliates</b>	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clackamas Federal Credit Union has no affiliates.</li> </ul>
<b>Nonaffiliates</b>	<p>Companies not related by common ownership and control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Nonaffiliates we share with can include direct marketing companies, mutual insurance companies, and financial advisor companies.</li> </ul>
<b>Joint Marketing</b>	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Joint marketing agreements can include direct marketing companies, mutual insurance companies, and financial advisor companies.</li> </ul>
